WINTER LAWN CARE TIPS FOR OUR SOUTHERN REGION:

- *Rake lawn thoroughly to remove fallen leaves, dead grass and other debris.
- *Mow less often & raise mower blades.
- *Mulch beds: Mulching conserves soil moisture. Make sure not to put mulch directly against the plant stem or tree trunk to avoid rot.
- *Adjust watering schedule: Reduce frequency and duration of watering to allow the lawn to go into dormancy normally.
- *Use an APP: A good lawn app for your phone that can send notifications and customized care for your lawn is *Scotts' My lawn: A Guide to Lawn Care*.
- *Follow Local Horticulturist Skip Richter on 740AM weekends, & on his website, FB, or Instagram. He has a good Lawn Care & Weed & Pest Schedule for our area.

Gentle Reminders:

- *With kids home during the holidays, keep an eye out for speeding vehicles, especially food and delivery drivers!
- *Leash pets when walking outside of your backyard
- *Clean up after your dog while walking
- *Please remember to put away Trash and Recycle bins the day of collection.
- *Note that the City mandates Heavy Trash NOT be put out until the day/night before pickup. Makes for neater neighborhoods & a well-maintained City.
- *Remember to cut up tree limbs in small bundles in order to be picked up.
- * Unused vehicles or non-running vehicles need to be moved out of the driveway or the street & stored in your garage or moved to a storage lot.

Keeping an older neighborhood neat and clean makes for better market values leaving good impressions for any prospective new buyers.
